- Gynecology for Adolescents including:
- » Puberty evaluation
- » Lack of menstrual periods
- » Irregular menstrual periods
- » Heavy menstrual bleeding
- » Polycystic ovary syndrome
- » Primary ovarian insufficiency
- » Other conditions of the female reproductive organs
- » Fertility counseling
- Reproductive Health Care for Adolescents including:

- Adolescent AIDS Program (AAP)—the nation's first HIV/AIDS center dedicated to teens and young adults, providing care, testing and preventive services (718-882-0023)
- Adolescent Weight Management—to evaluate and help overweight teens shed pounds in a healthy way
- Contraception and Menstrual Management for Girls with Complex Medical Conditions—by nationally recognized experts in the field of adolescent gynecology
- Eating Disorder Program—offering adolescents struggling with eating disorders specialized medical and mental health care (718-741-2386)
- Girls Bleeding Program (GAB)—multidisciplinary program providing diagnosis and management of heavy menstrual bleeding and blood disorders in young girls (718-741-2342)
- IUD and Contraceptive Implant for Adolescents—providing IUDs and implants in a confidential environment for contraception or menstrual control, we have the ability to do these device insertions under sedation for intellectually/physically disabled girls who need menstrual control
- LGBTQ+ Program for Youth and Families—comprehensive support and medical care for lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgender adolescents ages 13–24
