



Dear Academic General Pediatrics Fellowship Applicant,

Thank you for your interest in the Academic General Pediatrics Fellowship at the Children's Hospital at Montefiore and the Albert Einstein College of Medicine. There are three parts to the application.

The **first** part is the Academic General Pediatrics Fellowship application form. Please complete this form in its entirety.

The **second** part is a one to two-page personal statement and curriculum vitae (CV). Please provide the CV and personal statement in separate files. (Save file separately in pdf format. Please title document as "first name last name CV/personal statement").

The **third** part consists of three letters of recommendation. Make sure each individual receives a <u>confidential reference report</u>. Please list on the application form the names and contact information of three physicians who will send letters on your behalf. A report must be submitted alongside each letter of recommendation. The letters of recommendations should be addressed to Suzette O. Oyeku MD, MPH and emailed directly to Dr. Suzette Oyeku and Dr. Sylvia Lim, Associate Fellowship Director. Email addresses are on the application form.

Please submit the completed application package (application form including list of references, personal statement and CV) electronically to Fellowship Coordinator, Ms. Jasmin Hernandez at jahernande@montefiore.org and Dr. Sylvia Lim with the subject line: "Academic General Pediatrics Fellowship Application".

We value diversity and encourage individuals from underrepresented, minority or disadvantaged backgrounds to apply. Once we have all three parts of your application, we will review the application materials and candidates will be invited for an interview.
